Uniform Policy

We are committed to Castle School providing a stress free learning environment where some of the pressures associated with 'growing up' are minimised. We believe pupils will have ample opportunity to express themselves at school without doing this through dress/jewellery/makeup etc.

All parents will receive a uniform list as outline below. Pupils will be asked to respect it and wear it properly. It is appreciated that parents have had to spend not inconsiderable sums on this uniform and the school will encourage children to look after it whilst at school. Pegs are provided and ample time for changing for sport has been allocated. Lab coats for science and aprons for ADT will be worn where appropriate.

In order to maintain high standards concerning uniform the school adopts a robust, zero tolerance policy on uniform issues. If a child comes to school incorrectly dressed we will take all necessary steps to rectify the situation that day. A note will be sent home pointing out the problem. If the situation persists, parents will be asked to come and discuss the matter with us.
